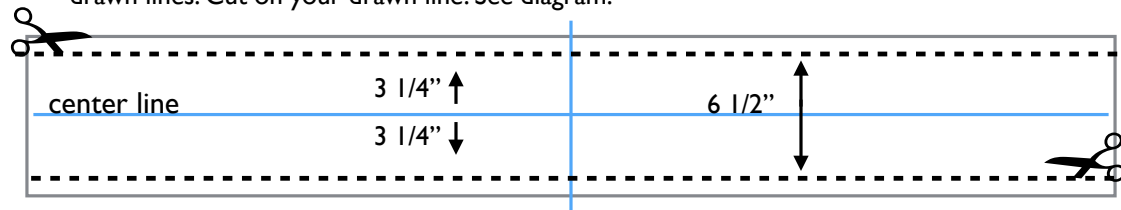
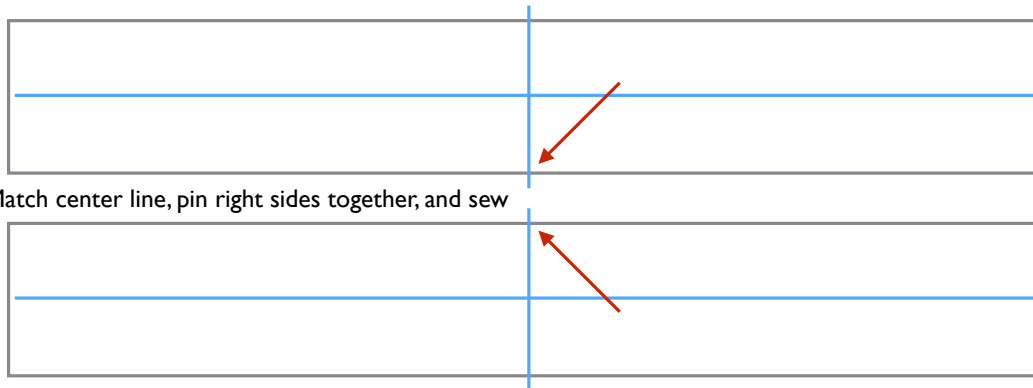


4. Trim each strip in width from 12 inches down to 6 1/2" inches. Do not trim the length of each. Measure out from the lengthwise center line 3 1/4" in both directions and draw a line for cutting. If your design placement was correct, all of your embroidery should be within these 2 drawn lines. Cut on your drawn line. See diagram.



5. Now you will sew the strips together. Using a quarter inch seam allowance, match each strip's center placement line you drew in Step 1 and pin. Sew the strips together in numerical order until they are all sewn together as one piece and should equal a length of 30 1/2". Press seams only.



6. Trim the width of this piece to 26 1/2" inches.
 7. Sew one of the (2) 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" red strips to each side. Press.
 8. Sew one of the (2) 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" red strips to each side. Press.
